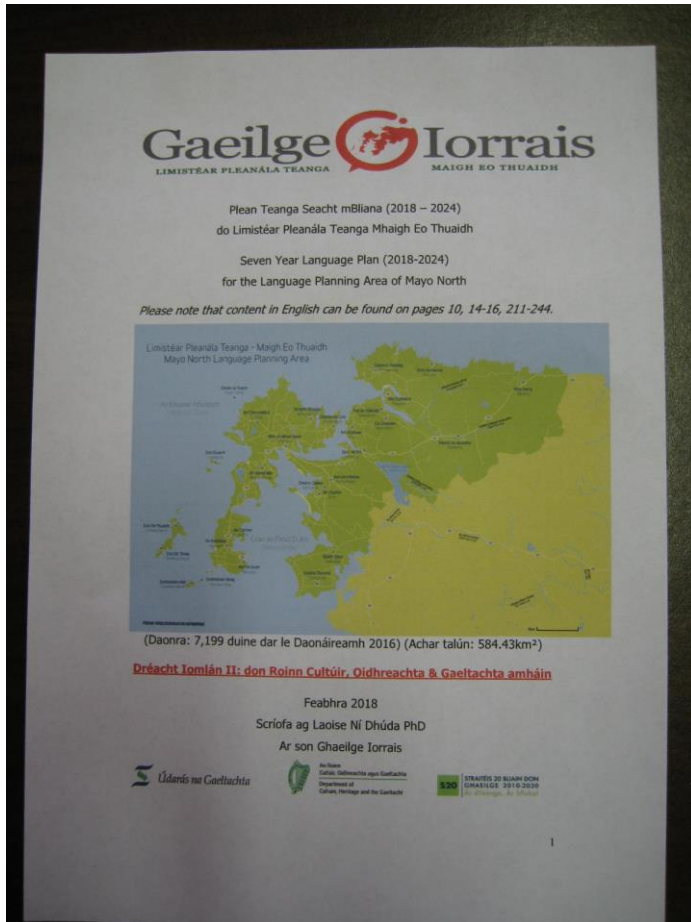

De réir Acht na Gaeltachta 2012, caithfidh chuile phobal Gaeltachta plean teanga a réiteach agus a chur i bhfeidhm chun tacú le húsáid na Gaeilge ina cheantar. Mura ndéantar é seo, tá baol ann go gcaillfear a stádas Gaeltachta. Tá Gaeilge Iorrais freagrach as an bpróiseas seo a stiúradh i limistéar Mhaigh Eo Thuaidh, i gcomhar le pobail áitiúla agus páirtithe leasmhara. Tá cónaí ar 7,199 duine nó thart ar 70% de dhaonra na Gaeltachta i Maigh Eo sa cheantar fairsing seo, a shíneann ón bhFód Dubh go Béal Deirg, ó Cheathrú Thaidhg go Dumha Thuama agus chuile áit idir eartartu. Ceapadh an Dr Laoise Ní Dhúda mar chomhairleoir pleanála teanga neamhspleách chun an obair seo a chomhordú.

*Tar éis próiseas chuimsitheach chomhairliúcháin, cuireadh **Plean Teanga Mhaigh Eo Thuaidh (2018-2024)** le chéile, ina leagtar amach 34 beart in 11 réimse difriúil. Beidh maoiniú ceart, acmhainní daonna cuí, rannpháirtíocht ghníomhach an phobail agus na n-údarás ag teastáil chun an plean a fheidhmiú go héifeachtach agus na spriocanna a chomhlíonadh.*

Cuireadh an plean faoi bhráid Údarás na Gaeltachta i lár mhí Eanáir agus tá sé imithe ar aghaidh chuig An Roinn Cultúir, Oidhreacht agus Gaeltachta ó shin. Ag leanacht uaidh seo, tosóidh plean feidhmithe seacht mbliana, nuair

a bheidh an plean faofa ag an Aire agus maoiniú ar fáil chun é a fheidhmiú.

Under Acht na Gaeltachta 2012 every Gaeltacht community must prepare and implement a language plan to support and develop Irish language use in their area. If they don't do this, they could lose their Gaeltacht status. *Gaeilge Iorrais* is responsible for overseeing this process in Maigh Eo Thuaidh (North Mayo Gaeltacht area), in consultation with local communities and various stakeholders. 7,199 people or c .70% of the Mayo Gaeltacht population live in this vast area, which spans from Fód Dubh to Béal Deirg, Ceathrú Thaidhg to Dumha Thuama and everywhere in between. Dr Laoise Ní Dhúda, an independent language planning advisor, was appointed to facilitate and co-ordinate the work required.

Following an extensive consultation process, the **North Mayo Language Plan (2018-2024)** was compiled where 34 recommendations or specific measures are proposed in 11 key areas. Adequate funding and human resources, as well as active community and agency participation will be required to implement the plan effectively, achieve targets and ensure community participation.

The plan was submitted to Údarás na Gaeltachta in mid-January and has since been forwarded to the Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht. Following on from this, a 7 year implementation programme will commence, pending plan approval and funding.

Ionad Seirbhísí Teanga na Seanscoile / Irish Language Centre

Le fada an lá tá buanú agus cur chun cinn na Gaeilge mar theanga pobail ar cheann de na príomhspríocanna atá ag Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo agus fo-choiste Ghlór na nGael. Chuige sin cuireadh Ionad Seirbhísí Teanga ar bun sa Seanscoil, áit a bhfuil seirbhísí teanga ar fáil de réir éilimh. Ins an ionad tá seomra oiliúna agus leabharlann le haghaidh ranganna Gaeilge, seisiúin chomhrá, cúrsaí aistriúcháin &rl. maraon le hacmhainní tacaíochta foghlama ar nós leabhair, téipeanna, físeáin agus bogábhar ríomhaireachta. Tá an t-ionad mar áis do scolairí, grúpaí áitiúla foghlama agus grúpaí a thugann cuairt ar an gceantar le Gaeilge a fhoghlaim nó le taighde a dhéanamh.

For many years the promotion of Irish as a community language has been one of the main objectives of Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo and its sub-committee Glór na nGael. An Irish Language Centre was established in the Seanscoil, where language services are available on demand. The centre houses a training room and library for Irish language classes, translation services etc. as well as learning resources such as books, tapes, videos and

computer software. The centre is a resource for students, local learning groups and groups who visit the area to learn Irish or to carry out research.

Seachtain na Gaeilge 2018



Is í Seachtain na Gaeilge, a bhí ar siúl ó lú go 17ú Márta, ceann de na féilte idirnáisiúnta Ghaeilge is mó. Mar chuid den chlár d'eagraigh Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo imeachtaí éagsúla ina measc oíche sheanchais faoi bhéaloideas an cheantair, ranganna damhsa traidisiúnta agus ranganna ceoil, scéalaíocht le páistí an naíonra, agus taispeántas grianghraif sa Seanscoil dar teidil 'Muintir Dhún Chaocháin'. Ba mhaith leis an gcoiste buíochas a ghlacadh le Conradh na Gaeilge as ucht a chomhoibriú. D'eagraigh Scoil Náisiúnta Cheathrú Thaidhg ócáid speisialta sa Seanscoil chomh maith nuair a tháinig páistí scoile agus daoine fásta le chéile chun chluichí cártaí a imirt.

Seachtain na Gaeilge, which took place this year from 1st to 17th March, is one of the biggest international Irish-language festivals. To coincide with this Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo organized various activities including a night of conversation and storytelling based on local folklore, traditional dancing and music classes, storytelling with children from the naíonra, and a photographic exhibition in the Seanscoil entitled 'Muintir Dhún Chaocháin'. The committee would like to thank Conradh na Gaeilge for its co-operation. Ceathrú Thaidhg National School also organized a special event in the Seanscoil where the schoolchildren and adults enjoyed an evening of card-playing.

Ranganna Gaeilge / Irish Classes

Teacháin a' Watch Look Out Post

Ag an bpointe is fuide amach ag Barr na Rinne, os cionn Cuan Phort a' Chlóidh, bhí foirgneamh beag a dtugtaí Teacháin a' Watch air. Mar chéim chosanta thóg Seirbhís na nGardaí Cósta na tithe faire seo ar feadh an chósta chun súil a choinneáil ar na báid cogaidh i rith an Dara Cogadh Domhanda. In aice láimhe tá uimhir an stáisiúin 'EIRE 63' leagtha amach ar an talamh le clocha bána agus d'fhéadfaí é a fheiceáil ón aer. Faraoid, leag stoirm an foirgneamh stairiúil seo go talamh. Tá iarrachtaí dá dhéanamh anois leis na heagraíochtaí cuí chun an foirgneamh a ath-thógáil, a chaomhnú agus a scéal a chur faoi bhráid an phobail.

Sa gCartlann Míleata i mBeairic Chathail Brugha, Baile Átha Cliath tá deich leabhar tuairisce, a scríobh na fir faire idir 09/09/1939 agus 15/06/1945. Tá siad le fáil anois i bhfoirm digiteach agus déantar cur síos laethúil iontu ar na himeachtaí a bhí ar siúl, mar shampla, na heitleáin agus na báid chogaidh a tháinig an bealach, na coirp agus na mianaigh a tháinig i dtír arl. Nuair a bhéas an tionscnamh seo críochnaithe beidh deis ag an bpobal na taifid seo a scrúdú don chéad uair.

Go dtí seo, tá comhoibriú agus tacaíocht iontach faighte againn ó Amelia Stein (Aosdana agus RHA) a bhfuil taighde cuimsitheach déanta aici ar an ábhar ; Micheál Ó Tuathail atá ag bailiú eolais ó na leabhair tuairisce ; An Dochtúir

Micheál Ó Cinnéide (cartlannaí sa gCartlann Míleata, Acadamh Ríoga na hÉireann agus údar an leabhair 'Guarding Ireland's Neutrality'); Stiofán Mac Eoin (Cartlannaí), Noelle Grothier (Leabharlannaí) agus Daniel Ayiotis sa gCartlann Míleata i mBeairic Chathail Brugha; Catriona Crowe; Eugene Mac Guidhir (Innealtóir Tógála); Pádraig Ó Dochartaigh agus rannphairtíthe Scéim Shóisialta Tuaithe Chill Chomáin; Ailtirí McCullough Mulvin atá ag cuidiú maidir le cleachtas ailtireachta; agus oifigeach siúlóide agus turasóireachta Chomhairle Chondae Mhaigh Eo Anna Connor.

De réir mar a théann an tionscnamh chun cinn déanfaidh Amelia agus triúr ealaíontóir clúiteach eile (mar atá Pat Harris, Mick O' Dea – Uachtarán Acadamh Ríoga na hÉireann, agus Linda Ruttelync) cur i láthair ar scéal an fhoirgnimh tré mheán na healaíne, na dealbhóireachta agus na ghrianghrafadóireachta. Tabharfar cuireadh do scoileanna áitiúla páirt a ghlacadh sa chuid seo den tionscnamh. Tá sé beartaithe agallaimh a dhéanamh le clanna na bhfear faire chomh maith ar mhaithe le cúrsaí béaloidis.

At Barr na Rinne overlooking Port a' Chlóidh Bay a former look out post, known locally as Teacháin a' Watch, was located. These look-out posts were built around the coast during World War II for the Coastwatching Service by the Office of Public Works. Nearby the number of the station 'EIRE 63' is outlined on the ground in quartz stone and this was visible from the air, a symbol of Ireland's neutrality. Unfortunately, this historic landmark was the victim of a storm which decimated the building. Efforts are now underway with the relevant authorities to re-erect and preserve the building and present its story to the wider community.

Ten logbooks, which were maintained by the voluntary Coast-watchers between 09/09/1939 and 15/06/1945, are housed in the Military Archives at Cathal Bruagh Barracks, Dublin. These are now digitized and contain a daily record of events including passing aircraft and sea-craft, bodies and mines washed ashore etc. The completion of the project will give the community an opportunity to examine these records for the first time.

To date we have received great co-operation and support from Amelia Stein (Aosdana and the RHA) who has carried out extensive research on the subject; Michael O' Toole who is collecting data from the logbooks; Dr Michael Kennedy (Executive Editor of Documents on Irish Foreign Policy in the Royal Irish Academy and author of the book *Guarding Ireland's Neutrality*); Stephen Mac Eoin (Archivist), Noelle Grothier (Librarian) and Daniel Ayiotis in the Military Archives at Cathal Bruagh Barracks; Catriona Crowe; Eugene Maguire (Construction Engineer); Pádraig Ó Dochartaigh and participants on the Cill Chomáin Rural Social Scheme; McCullough Mulvin Architects who are offering assistance on architectural practice; and Mayo County Council walking and tourism officer Anna Connor.

As the project progresses Amelia and three other renowned artists (Pat Harris, Mick O' Dea - President of the Royal Irish Academy, and Linda Ruttelync) will depict the story of the watch house through the medium of art, sculpture and photography. Local schools will be invited to engage in this aspect of the project. It is also planned to interview the descendants of the Coast-watchers to create an oral history of their memories.

Scéalta Eile / Other News

Siúlóidí / Ceathrú Thaidhg Walks

Tá Siúlóidí Ceathrú Thaidhg (Lúb Chlann Lir, Lúb an Chlaí Dhuibh agus Lúb na Binne Buí) ag mealladh cuairteoirí isteach sa gceantar le cúpla bliain anois le blas a fháil ar thírdhreach agus ar radharcanna maorga Dhún Chaocháin. Ag tosnú amach agus ag críochnú ó lárionad na Seanscoile, tá gach siúlóid treormharcáilte le dath difriúil ag brath ar a dianacht (glas - easca, gorm - measartha & dearg - dian). Déanann clár eolais agus bróisiúr dá-theangach ildaite cur síos ar sonraí na mbealaí agus ar phointí suimiúla. Is féidir iad a fheiceáil ar an suíomh idirlíne www.mayotrails.ie chomh maith.

Described as the most spectacular sea-cliff scenery in Ireland, the Ceathrú Thaidhg loop walks (Lúb Chlann Lir, Lúb an Chlaí Dhuibh and Lúb na Binne Buí) continue to attract visitors to the area. Starting and finishing at the

Seanscoil community centre, each loop is waymarked and colour-coded according to its level of difficulty (green - easy, blue - moderate & red - difficult). A bi-lingual information board and brochure provide details on trail directions and points of interest en route. They can also be viewed on the website www.mayotrails.ie

An Táin Bó Flíodhais / The Cattle Raid of Mayo



Tá formhór na ndaoine ar an eolas faoin scéal miotasach Táin Bó Cuailgne, ach níl an oiread sin eolas ar scéal ársa eile, sé sin an Táin Bó Flíodhais nó Táin Mhaigh Eo. Déanann sé seo cur síos ar an tslí a lean arm Mheadhbh, ó Ráth Chruacháin i gCondae Ros Comáin isteach go hIorras ar ruaig chreicthe eallaigh. Tá an tírdhreach breactha le sean-láithreáin atá luaite go sonrach sa scéal.

Tá réamh-thaighde déanta ag grúpa oibre ar an Táin chun na féidearthachtaí teangeolaíocha, cultúrtha agus turasóireachta a chur chun cinn.

Déanfaidh baill an choiste Anthony Brogan agus Jim Henry cur i láthair ar an téama 'The Archaeological Sites Associated with the Táin Bó Flíodhais' ag comhdháil i gCruachán Ai ar an 14ú Aibreán. Anuas ar sin, tá an coiste ag eagrú féile trí lá i Meitheamh ina dtabharfar cuairt ar chuid de na suíomhanna tábhachtacha ársaí ag Achadh Mór, Leath-ardáin agus Gleann a'Chaisil. Mar chuid den chlár eagrófar comhdháil ina mbeidh aoichainteoirí mar Andrew McDougall & Dr Ulrike Hogg (Leabharlann Náisiúnta na hAlban), Colmán Ó Raghallaigh (Cló Mhaigh Eo) agus Daniel Curley (Bainisteoir Chruacháin Ai) ag déanamh cur i láthair ar an ábhar. Is féidir breis eolais a fháil ó Anthony Brogan ag 087 9544468.

Most people are familiar with the Ulster Cycle of Celtic mythological tales including the *Táin Bó Cuailgne*. What is less well known is the story of the *Táin Bó Flíodhais*, a first century epic saga describing a cattle raid which brought Queen Meadhbh and her army from Ráth Chruacháin in County Roscommon on a journey through Mayo to reach their final destination in Erris. The purpose of this venture was to steal away the queen, Flíodhais, along with her Maol or bountiful hummel cow from Ráth Muireagáin near Gleann a' Chaisil. As the plot unfolds we are drawn in by events which were driven by power, greed, lust, vengeance and deceit.

A working group has carried out preliminary research on the Táin with a view to highlighting its potential as a linguistic, cultural and tourism product in the context of the great Irish cattle raid sagas. Committee members Anthony Brogan and Jim Henry will give a presentation entitled '*The Archaeological Sites Associated with the Táin Bó Flíodhais*' at a conference in Cruachán Ai, Tulsk on 14th April. The committee is also organizing a three-day festival in June, with visits to some of the important ancient sites at Achadh Mór, Lathardaun and Gleann a' Chaisil.
