Turas Eaneolaíochta / BirdWatch Trip

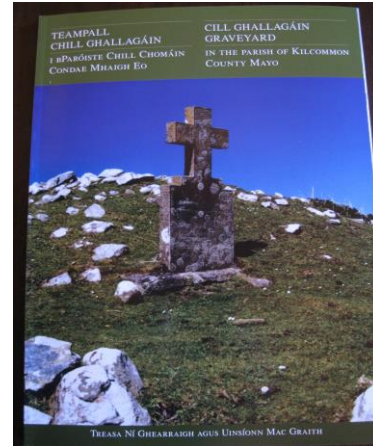


Teacháin a' Watch agus ÉIRE 63

Tá Teacháin a' Watch suite ar cheann tíre ar an taobh thiar de Chuan Phort a' Chlóidh. Mar chéim chosanta thóg Seirbhís na nGardaí Cósta trí chinn is ceithre scór de na tithe faire seo ar feadh an chósta i 1941 chun súil a choinneáil ar na báid cogaidh i rith an Dara Cogadh Domhanda. I gCartlann Míleata, Sráid Chathail Brugha, Baile Átha Cliath tá deich leabhar tuairisce le fáil maidir leis an bhfoirgneamh seo agus na himeachtaí a bhí ar siúl ann. In aice láimhe tá uimhir an stáisiúin 'EIRE 63' leagtha amach ar an talamh le clocha bána. Le himeacht ama áfach bhí fraoch agus caonach ag fás ar na clocha agus ba doiligh iad a fheiceáil. Ach buíochas le hiarrachtaí rannphairtithe na Scéime Shóisialta Tuaithe Chill Chomáin tá athnuachan déanta ar an gcomhartha, atá anois chomh soiléar is a bhí sé an chéad lá.

Teacháin a' Watch is situated on a headland to the west of Port a' Chlóidh Bay. This look out post is one of eighty three built around the coast in 1941 for the Coastwatching Service to monitor warships during the Second World War. Ten logbooks in the Military Archives at Cathal Brugha Street in Dublin document activities associated with it. Nearby the number of the station 'EIRE 63' is outlined on the ground in quartz stone. With the passing of time however, this had become overgrown and was barely visible, until thanks to the efforts of participants on the Cill Chomáin Rural Social Scheme it has been restored to its original condition.

Mná Tí who provide accommodation for Irish Summer College students are concerned that Scéim na bhFoghlaimoírí Gaeilge, which is administered by The Department of Community, Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs, may be shelved. The scheme affords students in non-Gaeltacht areas an

opportunity to experience Irish as an everyday spoken language and helps to improve their fluency in the language. It is an important source of income in Gaeltacht areas, which are recognized as the most disadvantaged and remote in the country, not only for the Mná Tí but also for bus services, shops, accommodation providers for visiting parents, Irish language teachers and the support team of the Colleges. Mná Tí from all over the country converged in the Conamara Coast Hotel on 2nd September where they handed in a petition and outlined their concerns to Minister Éamonn Ó Cúiv.

Even taking account of the global economic downturn, it is clear that the current economic situation has been brought about partly by gross mis-management at government level and by the irresponsible behaviour of the financial institutions. Although The Mc Carthy report has serious implications for every government department, it is the cutbacks and re-structuring that are recommended in the Department of Community, Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs which will have the greatest impact on the Irish language and on Gaeltacht communities. In the report it is recommended for example that:-

The Department of Community, Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs be disbanded

Matters pertaining to the Irish Language and the Gaeltacht be transferred to the Department of Education and Science

The schemes Scéim Labhairt na Gaeilge and Scéim na bhFoghlaimoirí Gaeilge be wound down over the next two years

The Housing Grant Scheme in Gaeltacht areas as well as The Gaeltacht Improvement Grants (roads, piers etc.) be abolished

A cross programme analysis of all expenditure on the Irish language be carried out

The enterprise development role of Údarás na Gaeltachta be transferred to the Industrial Development Authority

The CLÁR and Dormant Accounts Schemes be abolished
