Ag cruinniú a d’eagraigh Conradh na Gaeilge, i gcomhar le Guth na Gaeltachta, in Óstán Menlo Park i nGaillimh ar an 21ú Eanáir léirigh na daoine a bhí i láthair ó heagrais Gaeilge na tíre a mí-shástacht le polasaí Gaeilge Fhine Gael i gcóras oideachais na tíre. D’iarr an cruinniú ar cheannaire Fhine Gael, Enda Kenny, tacú leis an nGaeilge mar chroí-ábhar don Ardeist agus droim láimhe a thabhairt leis an moladh atá déanta roimhe seo ag Fine Gael ábhar roghnach a dhéanamh den Ghaeilge.

Léiríonn gach aon bhlúire d’fhianaise atá ar fáil nach mbíonn dea-thoradh ar pholasaithe trína ndéantar ábhar roghnach de theangacha i scrúduithe stáit. Tar éis 2001 nuair a rinneadh ábhar roghnach de na teangacha iasachta don *General Certificate of Secondary Education*

(GCSE) i Sasana, tháinig meath tubaisteach ar líon na ndaltaí a thug faoi theangacha a fhoghlaim. Laghdaigh líon na ndaltaí a thug faoi theanga iasachta don GCSE ó 78% in 2001 go 44% in 2009. Anuas air sin, b’isle i bhfad an líon daltaí a dhéanfadh staidéar ar theanga iasachta mar ábhar murach gur chloígh roinnt mhaith scoileanna príobháideacha leis an éigeantas.

Chomh maith leis seo, nuair a cuireadh deireadh leis an riachtanas iontrála Gaeilge a bhain le post a fháil sa státseirbhís i 1974, tháinig titim ollmhór ar chumas bhaill foirne na státseirbhíse seirbhís iomlán a chur ar fáil trí Ghaeilge. Mar shampla, níl ach 1.5% d’fhoireann na Roinne Oideachais agus Scileanna anois in ann seirbhísí a sholáthar trí Ghaeilge. Tagann an fhíríc sin salach ar an tuairim a nocht Fine Gael i 1974 go ndéanfaí úsáid na Gaeilge sa státseirbhís a neartú dá gcuirfí deireadh leis an éigeantas a bhain léi mar theanga: *“Tá an Rialtas lánmhuiníneach go músclóidh na hathruithe seo, a chuireann spreagadh in áit éigeantais, dea-mhéin bhreise don Ghaeilge agus go gcuideoidh siad le leathnú na teanga laistigh agus lasmuigh den státseirbhís trí atmaisféar níos fabhraí a chothú di”*. (An tAire Richie Ryan, 5ú Nollaig 1974).

Go deimhin, d’admhaigh Conor Cruise O’Brien, a bhí ina Aire sa Rialtas céanna, go raibh aiféala air go ndearnadh cinneadh dá leithéid: *“... d’abróinn gur tugadh, gan amhras, céim síos don Ghaeilge. Mar sin, ag féachaint siar ar ar tharla, ní shílím anois gur dheineamar an rud ceart. Agus cuireann seo an-bhrón orm”*. (24ú Lúnasa 1984). Níl aon amhras ná go mbeidh na himpleachtaí tromchúiseacha céanna i gceist le deireadh a chur leis an nGaeilge mar ábhar éigeantach san Ardeistiméireacht, mar atá beartaithe ag Fine Gael.

D’aontaigh an cruinniú go bhfuil fadhbanna maidir le múineadh agus le foghlaim na Gaeilge i scoileanna na tíre seo, agus gur gá tabhairt faoi réiteach a aimsiú lom láithreach trí na beartais atá luaite i *Straitéis 20 Bliain don Ghaeilge 2010 – 2030* a chur i bhfeidhm, mar shampla (i) ábhar amháin mar drámaíocht, corpoideachas, ealaín arl. sa bhreis ar an nGaeilge, a mhúineadh trí Ghaeilge do gach dalta bunscoile agus tacaíocht agus oiliúint chuí a chur ar fáil le sin a dhéanamh agus (ii) cuir leis an tréimhse ama atá i gceist le hoiliúint múinteoirí agus cur lena dtréimhse sa Ghaeltacht, chomh maith le deis a thabhairt do mhúinteoirí reatha freastal ar dhianchúrsaí sa Ghaeltacht.

Bheithfí ag súil go mbeadh toradh fiúntach, fadtéarmach ar mholtaí dearfacha dá leithéidí sin agus nach mbeidh ach an t-aon toradh amháin ar mholadh Fhine Gael deireadh a chur leis an nGaeilge mar ábhar éigeantach don Ardeistiméireacht, i. bás teanga.

At a meeting organised by Conradh na Gaeilge, in conjunction with Guth na Gaeltachta, held in the Menlo Park Hotel in Galway on 21st January representatives from Irish organizations throughout the country outlined their concerns at Fine Gael’s policy in relation to the Irish language in the education system. The meeting requested that Fine Gael leader, Enda Kenny should reverse the party’s stated policy of making Irish an optional subject at Leaving Certificate level.

All available evidence points to the failure of such a policy. In England, when languages were made optional at General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE) level, the amount of pupils who undertook language

subjects dropped dramatically from 78% in 2001 to 44% in 2009. In fact there would have been a much larger decline except that many private schools chose to continue with their policy of mandatory language study.

When the Fine Gael coalition government scrapped the Irish language requirement for the Civil Service in 1974, their rhetoric was very similar to that used by the party today in recommending making Irish an optional subject in the Leaving Certificate: "The government is fully confident that this policy change, which promotes encouragement instead of compulsion, will result in increased goodwill towards the Irish language and will help to widen language use inside and outside the Civil Service". (Minister Richie Ryan, 5th December 1974).

However, the practical results were a rapid decline in the ability of civil servants to provide services through the medium of Irish to the extent that in the Department of Education today, only 1.5% of civil servants can do so. Conor Cruise O'Brien, a minister in the same government, subsequently expressed regret at this decision: "...I would say that without a doubt Irish was reduced in status. Therefore, in retrospect, I do not believe we did the right thing. And I am very sorry about it". (24th August 1984) Fine Gael's proposed policy change, if implemented, will have similarly serious consequences.

The meeting acknowledged that there are problems in relation to the teaching and learning of the Irish language in our schools, and that these problems must be addressed without delay. It recommended implementing the measures contained in the recently published 20 Year Strategy for the Irish Language for example (i) The gradual introduction of the teaching of another subject through the medium of Irish, for example drama, physical education, art etc. at primary school level and (ii) The improvement of teacher training including an extension of the time trainees spend in the Gaeltacht and the provision of intensive Irish language courses in the Gaeltacht for existing teachers.

Positive measures like these should be of longterm benefit to the language instead of the current Fine Gael policy which endangers the very future of the language.

Seachtain na Gaeilge

Is mórfhéile náisiúnta í Seachtain na Gaeilge a dhéanann comóradh ar an teanga Gaeilge agus ar an oidhreacht agus cultúr Ghaelach. I gcaitheamh na féile, a bhí ar siúl idir an 5^ú agus an 17^ú Márta, eagraíodh sraith imeachtaí in ionaid éagsúla ar fud paróiste Chill Chomáin, ina measc taispeántas grianghraif dar teidil 'Muintir Dhún Chaocháin', seisiúin cheoil, ranganna Gaeilge agus ciorcal comhrá, taispeántas cócaireachta chun biachlár speisialta a phleanáil le haghaidh Lá Fhéile Pádraig agus mórshiúl na Féile Pádraig le hábhair spéise le haghaidh óg agus aosta.

Seachtain na Gaeilge is a national festival which celebrates the Irish language, heritage and culture. During the festival, which ran from the 5th to the 17th March, a series of activities were organised in various venues throughout the parish of Cill Chomáin. The packed programme included a photographic exhibition entitled 'Muintir Dhún Chaocháin', music, Irish language classes, a cookery demonstration to plan a special menu for Saint Patrick's Day and the Saint Patrick's Day Parade with attractions to suit young and old.

Seirbhísí Aosach/ Services for the Elderly

Cuireadh Cumann Gníomhaíochta Aosach Chill Chomáin ar bun i 1998 agus í mar phríomhaidhm aige dul i ngleic le neamhionannas, easpa seirbhísí agus deacrachtaí teacht ar sheirbhísí aosach i bparóiste Chill Chomáin, sa gcaoi is go bhfeabhsófaí caighdeán maireachtála an spriocghrúpa seo. I gceantar iargúlta tuaithe mar seo airíonn go leor daoine aosta scoite amach agus tá an-thabacht ag baint lena dteagmháil le baill an choiste, a choinníonn ar an eolas iad ar imeachtaí an phobail. Bailítear óna dtithe chuile Mháirt agus iompraítear chomh fada le h-ionad pobail Ghleann na Muaidhe iad, áit a n-eagraítear imeachtaí éagsúla mar aclaíocht éadrom, ceirdeanna, ceol agus amhránaíocht.

Eagraítear turasanna lae, agus go dáta thug an grúpa cuairt ar Ionad an Athar Peyton (i mí Aibreáin chuile bhliain), Mainistir Mhaigh Eo, Ionad Oidhreachta Deirbhíle ar an Eachléim, Teach na bPaidreacha in Acaill agus Cnoc Mhuire (i mí Bealtaine chuile bhliain). Eagraítear turasanna trí lá chomh maith, i Meitheamh agus Meán Fómhair, a thugann deis do bhaill an ghrúpa bualadh le grúpaí eile aosach ó cheantar Iorrais.

Is ócáid mhór é cóisir na Nollag i gclár imeachtaí na bliana agus bíonn suas le ceithre scór daoine aosta ag freastal air de gnáth. Tá tabhacht ar leith le cúrsaí sábháilteachta i saol na n-aosach, go mórmhór iad siúd atá ina gcónaí leo féin. Le dul i ngleic leis seo, cuireann an coiste eolas praiticiúil agus trealaimh mar ghutháin speisialta, soilse céadfaigh arl. ar fáil.

Tá an coiste go mór faoi chomaoin ag Feidhmeannacht na Seirbhíse Sláinte, Clár Forbartha Áitiúil Iorrais agus Clár Leader Mhaigh Eo a chuireann módh taistil ar fáil faoin gClár Taistil Tuaithe. Set up in 1998, the Kilcommon Activity for the Elderly Group's main objective is to address and overcome issues relating to inequality, inaccessibility and deficiency of services for elderly people in the parish of Kilcommon with a view to improving their quality of life. In what is a peripheral rural area, many elderly people feel isolated and value their contact with members of the committee who provide a vital link with the wider community. The elderly are collected from their homes every Tuesday and transported to the community centre in Gleann na Muaidhe to partake in various activities including light exercise, crafts, music and sing song.

Day trips are organised and to date the group has visited the Fr. Peyton Centre in Attymass (in April of each year), Mayo Abbey, Ionad Deirbhíle Heritage Centre in Eachléim, The House of Prayer in Achill and the Basilica in Knock (in May of each year). Three-day trips further afield are also organised in June and September and give members of the group an opportunity to socialise with other elderly activity groups from Erris.

The annual Christmas party, which is attended by up to eighty senior citizens, is a big event in the group's activity schedule, and has proved to be a great success. The issue of safety is an important one in the lives of

elderly people, particularly those living alone. To help address this, the committee provides practical information and equipment such as pendant phones, sensor lights etc.

The committee would like to acknowledge the assistance received from the Health Services Executive, Erris LDP and Mayo North East Leader which provides transport through the Rural Transport Scheme. Grúpa ar Chuaire / Visiting Group
