Is comharchumann forbartha pobail é Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo atá cláraithe le Clárlann na gCarachumann. Tá sé mar ráiteas misin aige oibriú go gníomhach ar shon forbairt theangeolaíochta/chultúrtha, bhonneagartha, oideachasúil agus shóisialta paróiste Chill Chomáin agus acmhainní nádúrtha agus daonna an cheantair a fhorbairt ar bhealach chomhtháite. Ag comhoibriú le Coiste Ghlór na nGael, grúpaí forbartha áitiúla agus eagraisí éagsúla stáit tá roinnt tograí curtha i gcrích go dáta.

Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo is a community development co-operative which is registered with the Registry of Friendly Societies. Its mission is to work in a proactive way to promote the linguistic/cultural, infrastructural, educational and social development of the parish of Cill Chomáin and to develop in an integrated way the material and human resources of the area. Working in conjunction with Coiste Ghlór na nGael, local development groups and various state agencies a number of projects have been undertaken to date.

Ag cruinniú cinnbhliana Chomhar Dún Chaocháin Teo sa Seanscoil ar an 19ú Samhain rinne an bainisteoir Treasa Ní Ghearraigh cur i láthair ar obair na bliana 2012.

Tá caomhnú agus cur chun cinn na Gaeilge ar cheann de na príomhspricanna atá ag an gcomharchumann. Léiríonn 'An Staidéar Cuimsitheach Teangeolaíoch ar Úsáid na Gaeilge sna Gaeltachtaí' go bhfuil dúthshlán roimh pobail agus eagraisí stáit atá ag feidhmiú sna ceantacha Gaeltachta an Ghaeilge a choinneáil beo mar theanga pobail i bhfianaise a phráinní is atá an staid reatha teanga. Eagraítear cúrsaí Gaeilge agus seirbhísí aistriúcháin in Ionad Seirbhísí Teanga na Seanscoile, áit a bhfuil acmhainní tacaíochta foghlama ar nós leabhair, téipeanna, fiseáin agus bogábhar ríomhaireachta le fáil ag scolairí, grúpaí áitiúla foghlama agus grúpaí a thugann cuairt ar an gceantar le Gaeilge a fhoghlaim nó le taighde a dhéanamh.

I gcomhar le hIonad na dTeangacha, Ollscoil na hÉireann, Má Nuad agus Údarás na Gaeltachta, tá cúrsaí gaeilge d'fhoghlaimoirí fásta faoi lánshéol chuile oíche Dé Máirt le Leibhéal A1 (le haghaidh tosaitheoirí) Leibhéal A2, Leibhéal B1 agus B2.

I measc na spriocghrúpaí a dhéanann an comharchumann freastal orthu tá páistí réamhscoile. Is seirbhísí réamhscoile trí Ghaeilge iad Naíonra Dhún Chaocháin, atá lonnaithe sa Seanscoil, agus Naíonra Ghleann na Muaidhe atá lonnaithe in ionad tacaíochta teaghlaigh i nGleann na Muaidhe. Faigheann na tograí cúraim leanaí seo airgeadú ón gClár Infheistíochta Náisiúnta Cúraim Leanaí, atá faoi chúram na Roinne Sláinte agus Leanaí agus atá maoinithe ag Rialtas na hÉireann faoin bPlean Forbartha Náisiúnta 2007-2013. Cuireann Feidhmeannacht na Seirbhíse Sláinte, Coiste Cúraim Leanaí Chondae Mhaigh Eo agus Comhar Naíonraí na Gaeltachta Teo tacaíocht agus comhairle ar fáil.



I mí Iúil eagraíodh campaí samhraidh i gCeathrú Thaidhg agus i nGleann na Muaidhe i gcomhar le Coiste Campaí Samhraidh Iorrais, faoi Scéim na gCampaí Samhraidh d'Aos Óg na Gaeltachta. Is í an Ghaeilge an teanga feidhme sna campaí, a chuireann imeachtaí siamsaíochta, oideachaisiúil agus cultúrtha ar fáil do pháistí bunscoile an cheantair.

Bunaíodh Óige na Gaeltachta Teo i 2006 chun seirbhísí óige go hiomlán trí mheán na Gaeilge a chur ar fáil do ghrúpaí /eagraíochtaí atá ag plé leis an óige ins na Gaeltachtaí ar fud na tíre. I Meán Fómhair, ar chuireadh ó Chlub Óige Cheathrú Thaidhg, rinne an t-oifigeach óige Joanne Ní Fhlatharta cur i láthair i gColáiste Chomáin, Ros Dumhach chun cúlra agus imeachtaí na heagraíochta a mhíniú do thuismitheoirí agus dhéagóirí áitiúla. Ó shin i leith tagann baill an chlub le chéile sa gColáiste chuile oíche Dé hAoine le haghaidh imeachtaí éagsúla. Eagraítear ranganna damhsa traidisiúnta agus ranganna ceoil sa Seanscoil chuile Aoine chomh maith le Nessa Ní Chuimlín a bhfuil céim sa Damhsa agus Ceol Gaelach bainte aici ó Ollscoil Luimnigh.



Leis na hathraithe atá tagtha ar chúrsaí eacnamaíochta agus ar shaol an phobail tá gá le scileanna nua a fhoghlaim nó barr feabhas a chur ar na scileanna atá ag daoine cheana féin sa gcáo is go mbeidh deis níos fearr acu fostaíocht a aimsiú nó a ngnó féin a bhunú. Eagraíodh agus rinneadh freastal ar roinnt cúrsaí oiliúna i rith na bliana ina measc Traenáil Inseirbhíse Réamhscoile i gcomhar le Comhar Naíonraí na Gaeltachta Teo agus Coiste Cúraim Leanaí Chondae Mhaigh Eo; ceardlanna bainistíochta le hÚdarás na Gaeltachta; taispeántais chócaireachta le Calann Uí Cheallaigh; lámhseáil meachain i gcomhar le Scéim Shóisialta Tuaithe Chill Chomáin agus cúrsa ríomhaireachta le Seán Ó Muineacháin.

Tá Siúlóidí Ceathrú Thaidhg (Lúb Chlann Lir agus Lúb an Chlaí Dhuibh) ag mealladh cuairteoirí isteach sa gceantar agus eagraíodh siúlóidí treoraithe i rith na bliana. Ag tosú amach agus ag críochnú ó lárionad na Seanscoile, tá gach siúlóid treormharcáilte le dath difrúil ag brath ar a dianacht. Déanann clár eolais agus bróisiúr dá-theangach ildaite cur síos ar sonraí na mbealaí agus ar phointí suimiúla. Agus é ag déanamh léargais ar shiúlóid Chlann Lir san Irish Independent, ba léir go ndeachaigh áilleacht an cheantair go mór i bhfeidhm ar an iriseoir Christopher Sommerville nuair a scríobh sé “What unrolled over the next couple of hours was one of the most breathtakingly wild and beautiful coastal walks I’ve ever encountered”. Rinneadh oibreacha forbartha ar Shiúlóid na Binne Buí i gcomhar le Scéim Shóisialta Tuaithe Chill Chomáin agus le hairgeadú Chomhairle Chondae Mhaigh Eo. Cuirfidh sé seo rogha siúlóide fad-bealaí ar fáil sa gceantar don chuirteoir.

Is feachtas féin-chabhrach Na Comhludair Bheo i dtreo bhonneagartha eacnamaíochta agus cultúrtha na háite a neartú. Sé aidhm na gluaiseachta ná próifil an cheantair mar tháirge nó mar cheann scríbe turasóireachta a ardú i measc tíortha Eorpacha mar An Fhrainc agus an Ghearmáin agus líon na dturasóirí a mhéadú. Tá suíomh cuimsitheach idirlíne ina ghné thabhachtach den bhfeachtas margaióchta atá le feiceáil ag www.gaeltacht.info áit a bhfuil rogha pacáistí saoire le fáil chun freastal ar ghrúpaí éagsúla.

Chríochnaigh Diana Taylor, atá ar an Scéim Fostaíochta Pobail, an suirbhé ar iarsmaí seandalaíochta an pharóiste, áit ar aimsigh sí go leor láithreáin speisiúla, tuamaí meigiliteacha san áireamh.



Is comhfhiontar é Seachtain Oidhreacht Náisiúnta idir Chomhairle na hEorpa agus Aontas na hEorpa, atá dá reachtáil ag An Comhairle Oidhreacht le tacaíocht na Roinne Ealaíne, Oidhreacht agus Gaeltachta agus Fáilte Éireann i mí Lúnasa. I rith na seachtaine d’eagraigh Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo trí imeacht rathúil - taispeántas grianghraif agus léiriú sleamhnáin ar ghnéithe áirithe de shaol na tuaithe mar a bhí san am a caitheadh i gceantar Dhún Chaocháin le hUinsíonn Mac Graith; cuir i láthair ar ghnéithe de sheandalaíocht Chill Chomáin le Diana Taylor, agus siúlóid dúlra ar bharr ailt ag Cill a’ Ghallagáin faoi threoir Shéamus Uí Mhongáin. Ba mhaith leis an gcoiste buíochas ó chroí a ghlacadh le chuile dhuine a d’frestal ar na himeachtaí agus le hOifig Oidhreacht Chomhairle

Chondae Mhaigh Eo a rinne páirt-mhaoiniú ar an gclár.

I Meán Fómhair eagraíodh Oíche Chultúir Náisiúnta faoi choimirce Thaisce Chultúrtha Bharra an Teampaill, le tacaíocht ón Roinn Ealaíon, Oidhreacht & Gaeltachta agus i gcomhar le Comhairle Condáe Mhaigh Eo agus eagraíochtaí cultúrtha ar fud na tíre. ‘Séard a bhí i gceist ná ceiliúradh a dhéanamh ar shuibhreas cultúrtha agus ealaíne na tíre agus deiseanna a chur ar fáil don bpobal a bheith rannpháirteach in imeachtaí éagsúla. Ghlac dhá ionad is fiche ar fud Mhaigh Eo páirt san imeacht, Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo ina measc. Eagraíodh ‘Ceardlann Damhsa ar an Sean-Nós’ sa Seanscoil leis an aoi speisialta Pádraig Ó Dubháin, a ghnóthaigh an chéad áit agus Corn Náisiúnta TG4 sa rannóg Rince Aonair ar an Sean-Nós ag an Oireachtas 2011.

Leanadh ar aghaidh leis an obair shuirbhéireachta ar na teampaill sa pharóiste. Leanann sé seo ar an obair atá foilsithe cheana féin ar Theampall Chill Ghallagáin agus ar Sean-teampall Pholl a’ tSomáis. Chríochnaigh Uinsíonn Mac Graith an suirbhé ar an teampall úr i Poll a’ tSomáis chun na huaigheanna uilig a mharcáil ar phlean, agus rinne Diana Taylor taiféad ar shonraí na gclocha cinn ag na teampaill ag Inbhear, Gleann na Muaidhe agus Greanáí.

Tá plean oibre timpeallachta an chomharchumainn dá chur i bhfeidhm faoi Scéim Shóisialta Tuaithe Chill Chomáin, atá dá reachtáil ag Cumann Lúthchleas Gael Chill Chomáin faoi scáth Údarás na Gaeltachta. I measc na hoibreacha a cuireadh i gcrích i 2012 bailíodh bruscair ar thránna agus ag na teampaill áitiúla mar chuid de bhfeachtais Glantachán Earraigh An Taisce agus Beartas in Aghaidh Bruscair Chomhairle Chondae Mhaigh Eo, tógadh balla cosanta gar don Alt Mór i bPort a’ Chlóidh, rinneadh obair chothabhála ar shiúlóidí Ceathrú Thaidhg agus oibreacha feabhsúcháin ar an Seanscoil.

Nuair a d'fhógair an tAire Comhshaoil, Pobal agus Rialtas Áitiúil, Phil Ó hÓgáin, gradaim an Chósta Ghlais 2012 ainmníodh trá Phort a' Chlóidh i measc na dtránna a bhain an gradam náisiúnta timpeallachta seo amach. Tá an gradam bunaithe ar thimpeallacht neamhmillteach, caighdeán ard uisce a chomhlíonann treoracha an Aontas Eorpach, agus áilleacht nádúrtha.

Bhí margadh ag Margadh Feirmeoirí Iorrais i gCearnóg Chartúir i mBéal an Mhuirthead chuile Shatharn i rith an tSamhraidh. Tugann an margadh feirmeoirí deis do dhaoine áitiúla dul i mbun táirgíochta agus seans do chaiteoirí bia úr, séasúrach agus caighdeánach ó cheantar Iorrais a bhlaiseadh.

I rith na bliana thacaigh an coiste le feachtas Guth na Gaeltachta agus Conradh na Gaeilge chun scéimeanna áirithe Gaeltachta a choinneáil agus rinneadh teagmháil le polaiteoirí ar an ábhar. Eagraíodh lá oscailte sa Seanscoil i mí Aibreáin chun an pobal a chur ar an eolas ar ról agus imeachtaí an chomharchumainn i bhforbairt pobail. Cuirtear eolas / cuidiú ar fáil do choistí deonacha ar chonas tograí a fhorbairt agus a bhainistiú, foinsí maoinithe arl. Tá eolas agus foirmeacha iarratais le fáil ar scéimeanna éagsúla cosúil le deiseanna traenála agus forbairt fiontair, maraon le seirbhísí cóipéala, laminating agus facs. Foilsíodh Nuachtlitir Chill Chomáin, nuachtlitir ceathrú, a chuireann guth ar fáil don phobal agus a choinníonn an pobal ar an eolas ar chúrsaí reatha.

Ba mhaith le Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo buíochas a ghlacadh leis na heagraisí seo a leanas a chuidigh leis i 2012 agus tá súil againn leanacht leis an gcomhoibriú i 2013 :- An Roinn Ealaíne, Oidhreacht agus Gaeltachta, Comhairle Chondae Mhaigh Eo, Údarás na Gaeltachta, FÁS, Comhpháirtíocht Spóirt Mhaigh Eo, Foras Chroí na hÉireann, An Roinn Sláinte agus Leanaí, Comhar Naíonraí na Gaeltachta Teo, Feidhmeannacht na Seirbhíse Sláinte, Coiste Cúraim Leanaí Chondae Mhaigh Eo, Barnardos, Fáilte Ireland, Foras na Gaeilge, Glór na nGael Teo, Óige na Gaeltachta Teo agus Coiste Gairmoideachais Chondae Mhaigh Eo.

At the Annual General Meeting of Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo in the Seanscoil on 19th November last the Manager Treasa Ní Ghearraigh gave a progress report for 2012.

The promotion and preservation of the Irish language is one of the main objectives of the comharchumann (co-op). The study 'Staidéar Cuimsitheach Teangeolaíoch ar Úsáid na Gaeilge sa Ghaeltacht – A Comprehensive Linguistic Study on the use of Irish in the Gaeltacht' illustrates the challenge facing communities and state agencies operating in Gaeltacht areas to preserve the Irish language, in light of the evidence of its decline as a community language. Irish language courses and Irish translation services are organised in Ionad Seirbhísí Teanga na Seanscoile (Language Centre) in Ceathrú Thaidhg where a special-purpose training room houses a library of learning resource materials including books, tapes, videos and computer software.

In conjunction with The Language's Centre, University College Maynooth and Údarás na Gaeltachta, The European Certificate in Irish (Teastas Eorpach na Gaeilge) courses are currently underway with Level A1 (Beginners), Level A2, Level B1 and B2 (intermediate) held on Tuesday nights.

Among the target groups catered for by the comharchumann are pre-school children. Naíonra Dhún Chaocháin in Ceathrú Thaidhg and Naíonra Ghleann na Muaidhe in Glenamoy are both community run, Irish language pre-school services which provide for the needs of children and their parents in these areas. These childcare projects currently receive funding from the Irish Government under the National Development Plan 2007 - 2013 through The National Childcare Investment Programme. The Health Services Executive, Mayo County Childcare Committee and Comhar Naíonraí na Gaeltachta Teo also provide assistance and advice.

In July Irish Summer Camps, which offer recreational, educational and cultural activities for local primary school children, were organised in Ceathrú Thaidhg and Gleann na Muaidhe in conjunction with Coiste Campaí Samhraidh Iorrais, with the assistance of funding received from Scéim na gCampaí Samhraidh d'Aos Óg na Gaeltachta.

Óige na Gaeltachta Teo was set up in 2006 to provide youth services through the medium of Irish for groups or organizations operating in Gaeltacht areas. On the invitation of Club Óige Cheathrú Thaidhg its youth officer Joanne Ní Fhlatharta gave a presentation in Coláiste Chomáin, Ros Dumhach in September to explain the organization's background and activities to local parents and young people. Youth club members now

meet in Coláiste Chomáin every Friday to take part in various activities. Traditional Irish dancing classes and music lessons are also organised in the Seanscoil every Friday with Nessa Timlin who has a Bachelor of Arts in Irish Music and Dance from the University of Limerick.

Lifelong learning and the acquisition of new skills is an ongoing process. A number of training courses were organised and attended during the year including Pre-School Inservice Training in conjunction with Comhar Naíonraí na Gaeltachta Teo and Mayo County Childcare Committee; Management training organised by Údarás na Gaeltachta; cookery demonstrations with Calann Kelly; manual handling in conjunction with Cill Chomáin Rural Social Scheme and a computer skills course taught by John Monaghan.



The Ceathrú Thaidhg loop walks (Lúb Chlann Lir and Lúb an Chlaí Dhuibh) continue to attract visitors to the area and guided walks were organised during the year. Starting and finishing at the Seanscoil community centre, each loop is waymarked and colour-coded according to its level of difficulty. A bi-lingual information board and brochure provide details on trail directions and points of interest en route. In a feature in the Irish Independent writer and journalist Christopher Sommerville described the Clann Lir walk as ‘... one of the most breathtakingly wild and beautiful coastal walks I’ve ever encountered’. Preliminary works were carried out on the Binn Bhúí Head Loop with the assistance of the Cill Chomáin Rural Social Scheme, and funding received from Mayo County Council.

This new route will offer the visitor the option of a long distance walk in the area.

Na Comhludair Bheo is a self-help initiative towards the economic and cultural revitalisation of the area. Its aim is to raise the profile of the area as a tourism product or destination particularly among European countries such as France and Germany. To help achieve this, a website has been designed which can be viewed at www.gaeltacht.info where a choice of holiday packages is available to cater for visiting groups.

An archaeological survey of the parish was updated by Diana Taylor, a participant on the community employment scheme. The survey unearthed a number of previously undocumented sites including possible megalithic tombs.

National Heritage Week, a joint initiative of the Council of Europe and the European Union, is co-ordinated by The Heritage Council with support from The Department of Arts, Heritage and the Gaeltacht and Fáilte Ireland in August. During the week Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo organised three very successful events - an exhibition of old photographs and a slide show, documenting aspects of the agricultural, maritime and folklore heritage of Dún Chaocháin by Uinsíonn Mac Graith; a lecture on the archaeology of the parish of Cill Chomáin by Diana Taylor, and a guided nature walk ‘Siúlóid Dúlra’ along the cliff-top at Cill a’ Ghallagáin led by Séamus Ó Mongáin. The committee gratefully acknowledges the support of all those who attended the events, and of Mayo County Council Heritage Office for part-funding the programme.



In September The Temple Bar Cultural Trust, with support from The Department of Arts, Heritage and the Gaeltacht, and in association with Mayo County Council and cultural organisations throughout the country, organised a National Cultural Night. The aim of the initiative is to celebrate the cultural and artistic richness of Ireland and to give communities an opportunity to partake in various activities. Twenty two venues in County Mayo participated including Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo, which organised a ‘Sean Nós Dancing Workshop’ in the Seanscoil with special guest Patrick Devane, winner of the TG4 National Trophy in the Sean-Nós Dancing category at the Oireachtas 2011.

Work on surveying the graveyards of the parish continued. This follows on from the material already published on Teampall Chill Ghallagáin and Teampall Chill Chomáin (Poll a' tSómais) old graveyard. Uinsíonn Mac Graith completed the survey of the new graveyard at Poll a' tSómais, marking the graves on a plan and recording the headstone details while Diana Taylor recorded the headstone details at Inbhear, Gleann na Muaidhe and Greanaí graveyards.

The Cill Chomáin Rural Social Scheme is managed by Cumann Lúthchleas Gael Chill Chomáin under the auspices of Údarás na Gaeltachta and includes an environmental workplan submitted by Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo. Some of the works carried out over the past year include refuse collection at local beaches and graveyards as part of An Taisce's National Spring Clean and Mayo County Council's Litter League initiatives, the construction of a stone wall at Alt Mór in Port a' Chlóidh, maintenance work on the Ceathrú Thaidhg walks and enhancement works at the Seanscoil in Ceathrú Thaidhg.

When the Minister for the Environment, Community and Local Government Phil Hogan announced the 2012 Green Coast Awards, Port a' Chlóidh beach was named as one of the recipients of this national environmental award. The award is based on a pristine environment, excellent water quality which complies with E.U. regulations, and natural beauty.

Margadh Feirmeoirí Iorrais (Erris Farmers Market) was held in Carter Square, Béal an Mhuirthead, every Saturday during the summer. The market provides a forum for local producers to develop new food initiatives and offers consumers the opportunity to savour fresh, seasonal produce from the Erris area.

During the year the committee supported Guth na Gaeltachta and Conradh na Gaeilge's campaign to retain Gaeltacht schemes and made representations to public representatives on these matters. An open day was organised in the Seanscoil in April inviting members of the community to drop in and familiarise themselves with the comharchumann's services and programme of work. The organisation's office provides information/assistance to voluntary groups in relation to developing and managing projects, sourcing funding etc. Information and application forms are available on various schemes including training opportunities and enterprise development, as well as photocopying, laminating and fax services. Nuachtlitir Chill Chomáin, a community newsletter, is published four times a year providing a voice for the local community and an update on development issues.

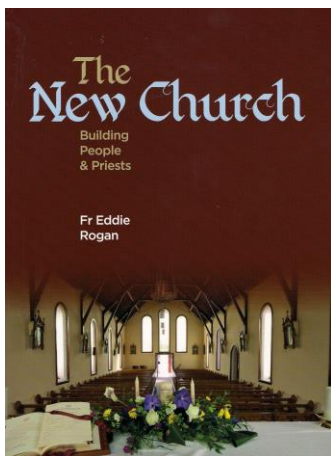
