Déanann an 'Staidéar Cuimsitheach Teangeolaíoch ar Úsáid na Gaeilge sa Ghaeltacht', a d'ullmhaigh Acadamh na hOllscolaíochta Gaeilge don Roinn Gnóthaí Pobail, Tuaithe agus Gaeltachta, mionanailís ar staid reatha na Gaeilge i gceantrachta éagsúla. Léirigh an staidéar gurb é Cnoc an Daimh an t-aon toghroinn ceantair i gCondae Mhaigh Eo atá i rannóg A, áit a labhrann níos mó ná 67% den dhaonra iomlán an Ghaeilge go laethúil. Tá an staidéar iomlán le fáil ar shuíomh idirlíne na Roinne Gnóthaí Pobail, Tuaithe agus Gaeltachta www.pobail.ie. Tá tuilleadh faoin ábhar seo ar leathanach 6.

Tá scéimeanna éagsúla le fáil anois le cuidiú le daoine fásta scileanna nua a fhoghlaim nó oideachas breise a bhaint amach (sonraí ar leathanach 4). Mar a deir an seanfhocal 'Ní hualach do dhuine an léann'.

The study states that Cnoc an Daimh is the only district electoral division in County Mayo in category A, where more than 67% of the total population are daily speakers of Irish. FEIRMEOIREACHT ORGÁNACH / ORGANIC FARMING

Mar gheall ar an méadú atá tagtha ar an éileamh le haghaidh bia orgánach tá deiseanna le fáil anois ag feirmeoirí/táirgeoirí a bheith páirteach sa réimse seo den mhargadh. Faoi láthair tá níos lú ná 1% de thalamh feirme na hÉireann faoi churaíocht orgánach i gcomparáid le 11% i dtíortha eile Eorpacha mar An Ostair agus an Ghearmáin. Tá sé mar aidhm ag an gClár Rialtais an ráta seo a ardú go dtí 5% faoin mbliain 2012 agus chuige sin tugadh isteach beartais mhaoinithe chun feirmeoirí a spreagadh le haistriú go táirgíocht orgánach. Cuireann ceann de na beartais seo, An Scéim Fheirmeoireachta Orgánach, maoiniú ar fáil d'feirmeoirí orgánacha gan iad a bheith páirteach i scéim REPS 4. Beidh feirmeoir orgánach anois i dteidil suas le €21,650 a fháil sa thréimhse aistrithe agus €15,860 in aghaidh na bliana nuair atá stádas iomlán orgánach bainte amach aige/aici faoi REPS. Beidh na daoine nach bhfuil páirteach sa scéim REPS i dteidil €11,660 a fháil sa thréimhse aistrithe agus €5,830 in aghaidh na bliana nuair atá stádas iomlán orgánach bainte amach aige/aici. Chun an pobal a chur ar an eolas faoin scéim agus na féidearthachtaí atá ann, d'eagraigh Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo seisiún eolais sa Seanscoil ar an 14ú Samhain áit a raibh Séamus Ó Mongáin agus Elaine Leavy ón eagrais Teagasc i láthair chun ceisteanna a fhreagairt agus comhairle a chur ar fáil.

Rinneadh mionphléigh ar chonas margáí tuaithe a bhunú agus a bhainistiú agus ar dea-chleachtas chaighdeán ag seisiún eolais a reachtáilleadh in Óstán Days i gCaisleán a' Bharraigh ar an 22ú Samhain. Thug an ocaíd, a bhí eagraithe ag Bord Forbartha Chonadae Mhaigh Eo, Leader agus Teagasc, deis do na daoine a bhí i láthair foghlaim ó thaithí táirgeoirí fadbhunaithe. I measc na n-aoichainteoirí bhí Patricia Golden (bainisteoir Margadh Feirme Origin i Mainistir na Búille), June Bourke (táirgeoir Margadh Tuaithe Chathair na Mart), Denise Roddy (Oifigeach Sláinte Timpeallachta i bhFeidhmeannacht na Seirbhíse Sláinte) agus Sue O' Toole (Comhlacht Forbartha Iar-Dheisceart Mhaigh Eo) a rinne cur i láthair ar fhoinsí maoinithe.

Ag seimineár eolais a reachtáilleadh sa Traveller's Friend i gCaisleán a' Bharraigh ar an 26ú Samhain chuir an aoichainteoir Trevor Sargent, Aire Stáit sa Roinn Bhia agus Ghairneoireachta, béim ar thabhacht bia áitiúil i dtaobh chaighdeán, séasúrachta agus inaimseachta. Rinne sé cur i láthair ar bheartais an rialtais chun an

fheirmeoireacht orgánach a chur chun cinn agus margáí tuaithe a bhunú, áit a bhfuil deis ag an táirgeoir na táirgí a dhíol go díreach leis an gceannaitheoir.

With the increase in demand for organically produced food there are now opportunities available for farmers/producers to become involved in this sector of the market. At present less than 1% of farming land in Ireland is cultivated organically compared to 11% in other European countries such as Austria and Germany. The Programme for Government aims to increase this figure to 5% by the year 2012 and has introduced various financial incentives to encourage farmers to convert to organic production. One of these incentives, The Organic Farming Scheme, provides financial support for organic farmers without having to participate in the new Rural Environment Protection Scheme (REPS 4). An organic farmer will now qualify for up to €21,650 during the conversion period and €15,860 a year with full organic status with REPS. Those who do not join REPS will still qualify for up to €11,660 during the conversion period and €5,830 a year once he/she has full organic status. To explain the scheme further and provide advice on other related issues such as suitable training courses, Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo organised an information evening in the Seanscoil on 14th November where Séamus Ó Mongáin and Elaine Leavy from the advisory agency Teagasc were available to answer questions.

An information evening held in Day's Hotel, Castlebar on 22nd November addressed the issue of establishing and managing country markets and the standards of best practice that apply. Organised by Mayo County Development Board, Leader and Teagasc, it gave those in attendance an opportunity to hear firsthand the experiences of established producers. Speakers included Patricia Golden (manager of Origin Farmers' Markets Boyle), June Bourke (a supplier of Country Markets in Westport), Denise Roddy (Environmental Health Officer with the Health Services Executive) and Sue O' Toole (South West Mayo Development Company) who outlined the financial supports which are available.

At a seminar in the Traveller's Friend Hotel, Castlebar on 26th November Trevor Sargent, Minister of State for Food and Horticulture, stressed the importance of local produce in terms of quality, seasonality and traceability and outlined the government's incentives to promote organic farming and the establishment of country markets, where the producer has an opportunity to sell directly to the consumer.

BANTRACHT DÚN CHAOCHÁIN

Tionóladh cruinniú cinnbliana Bantracht Dún Chaocháin sa Seanscoil i gCeathrú Thaidhg ar an 20ú Samhain. Bunaíodh Bantracht Dún Chaocháin i 1996 agus iad mar phríomhaidhmeanna aige (i) dul i ngleic le heaspa seirbhísí agus deiseanna atá le fáil ag mná i gceantar Dhún Chaocháin (ii) deiseanna forbartha pearsanta, oiliúna agus sóisialta a chothú agus (iii) grúpa tacaíochta a chur ar fáil do mhná sa bpobal. Cuirtear béim ar ghníomhaíochtaí a chothaíonn forbairt pearsanta, féin-mhuinín agus a chuidíonn le mná ról níos láirní a bheith acu i bhforbairt pobail.

Rinne an Cathaoirleach, Máire Cáit Uí Mhurchú, tagairt ina tuairisc do na himeachtaí a bhí idir lámhe ag an ngrúpa i rith na bliana. Ceann de na hábhair is mó inní do mhná sa lá atá inniú ann ná an méadú atá tagtha ar ailt brollaigh. Chun tacú le feachtais Daffodil Day, a eagraíonn Cumann Ailt na hÉireann ar fud na tíre, eagraíodh maidin caife i mí Márta agus bailíodh €332 i dtreo na cúise fiúntach seo. Eagraíodh maidin caife i mí Mean Fómhair chomh maith ar mhaithe le Oispis Mhaigh Eo-Ros Comáin agus bailíodh €258 don eagrais.

Mír thabhachtach d'fhorbairt phearsanta is ea oiliúint fadsaoil agus chuige sin d'eagraigh agus d'freastal baill an coiste ar chúrsaí éagsúla oiliúna ina measc ranganna gúnadóireachta agus ceardaíochta (teagascóir Máire Uí hÉalaí le hairgeadú ó Choiste Gairmoideachais Condae Mhaigh Eo), cúrsa ullmhú bia FETAC Leibhéal 5 (teagascóir Mairín Uí Mhurchú le hairgeadú ó Meitheal Forbartha na Gaeltachta Teo agus FÁS), cúrsa turasóireachta tuaithe (teagascóir Marie Heneghan ó Teagasc) agus ranganna Gaeilge (teagascóir Síle Uí Mhurchú le hairgeadú ó Choiste Gairmoideachais Condae Mhaigh Eo). D'freastal baill an ghrúpa ar Lá Idirnáisiúnta na

mBan, a d'eagraigh Iorras le Chéile, áit a raibh deis acu páirt a ghlacadh i seisiún ceisteanna agus freagraí le painéal polaiteoirí. Ábhar sláinte agus cearta na mban is mó a bhí faoi chaibidil. Ag deireadh an chruinniú ghabh an Cathaoirleach buíochas le baill an choiste as a gcomhoibriú i rith na bliana agus ainmníodh na hoifigí seo a leanas ar an gcoiste don bhliain atá amach romhainn:- Máire Cáit Uí Mhurchú (Cathaoirleach), Treasa Ní Ghearraigh (Rúnaí) agus Sorcha de Búrca (Cisteoir).

The Annual General Meeting of Bantracht Dún Chaocháin took place on 20th November in the Seanscoil in Ceathrú Thaidhg. Set up in 1996, Bantracht Dún Chaocháin's main objectives are (i) to address the lack of services and opportunities available to women in the Dún Chaocháin area (ii) to provide personal development, training and social opportunities and (iii) to provide a support group for the women of the area. Emphasis is placed on activities which nurture personal development and self confidence and empower women to have a stronger voice in the future development of their community.

The outgoing Chairperson, Máire Cáit Uí Mhurchú, outlined in her report the main activities of the group over the year. One of the important issues affecting women today is the high incidence of breast cancer. To lend its support to the Daffodil Day initiative, which is organised by the Irish Cancer Society, the committee held a coffee morning in March which raised €332 towards this worthwhile cause. A coffee morning organised in September also raised €258 towards the Mayo-Roscommon Hospice Foundation.

An important aspect of personal development is lifelong learning and the acquisition of new skills. Members of the committee organised/attended various training courses including dressmaking and craft classes (tutor Máire Uí hÉalaí with funding received from Mayo Vocational Education Committee), A FETAC Level 5 Food Preparation Course (tutor Mairín Uí Mhurchú, funded by Meitheal Forbartha na Gaeltachta and FÁS), An Introduction to Rural Tourism (tutor Marie Heneghan, Teagasc) and Irish language classes (tutor Síle Uí Mhurchú, funded by Mayo Vocational Education Committee). Members of the group also attended International Womens Day, which was organised by Iorras le Chéile, and provided a forum for a question and answer session with various political representatives. Issues addressed included womens health and their rights as citizens. In concluding the Chairperson thanked the committee for its cooperation during the year and

the following officers were appointed to the committee for the forthcoming year:-Máire Cáit Uí Mhurchú (Cathaoirleach), Treasa Ní Ghearraigh (Rúnaí) and Sorcha de Búrca (Cisteoir).

An Staidéar Teangeolaíoch / The Linguistic Study

Léirigh an 'Staidéar Cuimsitheach Teangeolaíoch ar Úsáid na Gaeilge sa Ghaeltacht' gurb é Cnoc an Daimh an t-aon toghroinn ceantair i gCondae Mhaigh Eo atá i rannóg A, áit a labhrann níos mó ná 67% den dhaonra iomlán an Ghaeilge go laethúil. Áirítear sa toghroinn seo na bailte fearainn Cill a' Ghallagáin, Ceathrú na gCloch, Ceathrú Thaidhg, Corrán Bui, Cnoc a' Ghairtéil agus Port a' Chlóidh. I mí Dheireadh Fómhair d'fhógair an tAire Éamon Ó Cúiv go bhfuil Coiste Rialtais, nó Coiste Comh-aireachta, le bunú chun scrúdú a dhéanamh ar an staidéar agus plean gníomhaíochta a chur le chéile agus nach mbeadh torthaí na hoibre sin le fáil go ceann bliana. Creideann go leor coistí agus eagraisí atá ag plé le cursaí Gaeilge go mba chóir céimeanna a thógáil láithreach bonn i bhfianaise a phráinní is atá an staid reatha teanga.

this and believe that immediate steps need to be taken in light of the evidence and the urgency of preserving the language.

The new programme proposes many changes which will have an impact on the provision of childcare services in the future.

Ag tosnú agus ag críochnú ag an Seanscoil, tugann said léargas ar thírdhreach agus ar radharcanna maorga Dhún Chaocháin. Tá treormharcanna le dathanna difrúla ar gach shiúlóid ag brath ar dhianacht mar seo a leanas – glas (easca), gorm (measartha) agus dearg (dian).

Tá sonraí na mbealaí leagtha amach ar chlár eolais dá-theangach, atá lonnaithe sa charr-chlós nua in aice na Seanscoile. Tá na siúlóidí anois san áireamh i nGreasán Náisiúnta Lúbanna de chuid Fáilte Ireland agus déanfar bolscaireacht orthu ar

bhróisiúr agus ar shuíomh idirlíne na heagraíochta sin. Is é Comhar Dún Chaocháin Teo agus Scéim Shóisialta Tuaithe Chill Chomáin a bhí i mbun an togra le cúnamh airgeadú ó Chomhairle Chondae Mhaigh Eo, Fáilte Éire agus An Roinn Gnóthaí Pobail, Tuaithe agus Gaeltachta.

Work has been completed on three loop walks in Ceathrú Thaidhg namely Siúlóid na Trá, Siúlóid Chlann Lir and Siúlóid an Chlaí Dhuibh. Starting and finishing at the Seanscoil, they offer the walker an opportunity to experience the wonderful landscape and scenery of Dún Chaocháin. Each loop is waymarked and colour-coded according to the level of difficulty as follows green (easy), blue (moderate) and red (hard).

Details of the routes are outlined on a bi-lingual information board, which is sited in the newly-developed carpark adjacent to the Seanscoil.
